Twin Sharing Room

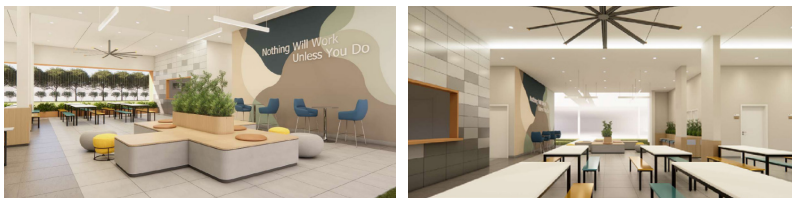

SUPPORTED STUDY ENVIRONMENT

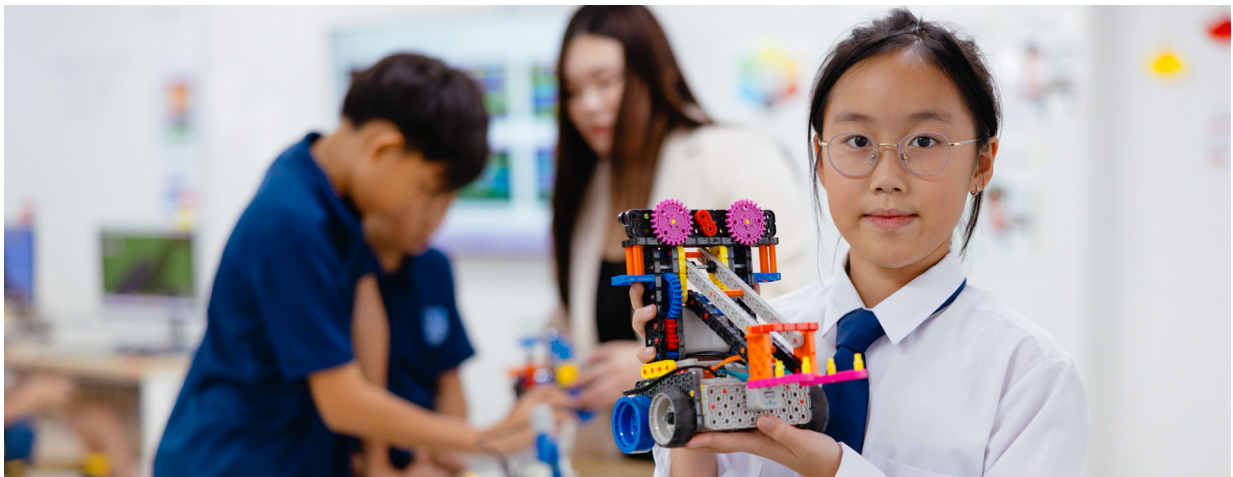
