PROGRAMME OF STUDY - TERM 1

UNIT 1 « FAMILLE ET DOMICILE »

- “Mon album de famille”. My family album. Talking about families. Using and practicing verbs belonging to the first group in French (ending in “er”)
- “Au boulot”. Jobs and occupation in French. Talking about jobs people do. Masculine or feminine jobs.
- “Où habitent-ils ?”. “Where do they stay?” Talking about where one lives. Countries and cities. Using the term “Depuis” in French which means can be translated by “Since” or “for” regardless.
- “Quel temps fait-il ?!” “What is the weather like today?” “Il fait beau / mauvais / chaud / froid” “Il y a du soleil / des nuages / ...” Using the connectives such as “Quand” & “Si”.
- “Une journée dans la vie de...”. “A day in the life of...”. Describing a typical day. Using French verbs belonging to the second (ending with “ir”) and third group (Irregular verbs). Authentic text.

UNIT 2 « TEMPS LIBRE »

- “Le weekend dernier”. “Last weekend”. Perfect tense in French. First level. Perfect tense with Auxiliary “avoir” followed by verbs ending in “er”. Past participles ending with “é”
- “Hier soir”. “Yesterday evening”. Perfect tense with Second level. Perfect tense with Auxiliary “avoir” followed by irregular verbs.
- “On a regardé la télé”. “We watched TV”. Wrap up lessons talking about TV programs as well as giving opinions using “C’était bien / mauvais / nul / intéressant / passionnant...”
- “Tu es sorti (e) samedi?”. “Did you go out last Saturday?”. Perfect tense in French. Third level. Perfect tense with Auxiliary “être” followed by a certain list of verbs (monter / descendre / entrer / sortir...). In this case, the past participles have to agree with the gender and the number of the pronoun.
- “Mon weekend”. “My weekend”. Talking about events in the past. Wrap up lesson. Extending and linking sentences
